To do so, you must send a written and signed request, accompanied by a photocopy of your ID/Passport, to the registered office indicated in the "Data Controller" section. The data subject has the right to withdraw consent at any time, without affecting the lawfulness of the processing based on the consent prior to its withdrawal. The data subject may lodge a complaint with the competent Data Protection Supervisory Authority, especially when he/she has not obtained satisfaction in the exercise of his/her rights, and how to contact the data controller.
