### “PUBLIC AWARD” WPA 2022

The "Public Award" is a section of the international water sports photography competition Ocean Power Watersports Photography Awards in which photos are submitted via **Instagram** and will be judged by **popular vote**.

### How to participate in the Public Award?

On **9 November 2022** at **19:00h** a post will be published on the Instagram account [@watersportphotographyawards](#) to open the Ocean Power WPA Public Award.

The participation method is as follows:

- Follow both accounts ([@oceanpowerphoto](#) and [@watersportsphotographyawards](#))
- Mention 2 friends (ocean lovers) in the post
- Post the photo you are entering the competition with in your stories\*, visibly mentioning (as shown in APPENDIX 1) [@oceanpowerphoto](#) and [@watersportsphotographyawards](#)
- Send the photo (without text) to [@watersportphotographyawards](#) by Instagram Direct Message

The deadline for submitting photos is **23 November at 23:59**.

Voting will take place from **25 to 30 November** via a link that we will publish on the website and on Instagram.

\*If your Instagram account is private, you must send a screenshot confirming that the photo has been duly published.

**FOR WHOM IS THE "PUBLIC AWARD" INTENDED?**

The "Public Award" is intended for all those people who like water sports and have taken a photo that they would like to represent. It is **NOT NECESSARY TO BE A PHOTOGRAPHER** to participate in this category.

**CAN PHOTOS TAKEN WITH MOBILE PHONES OR SPORTS CAMERAS BE SUBMITTED?**

The photos can be taken with any device, be it a mobile phone, a sports camera (GoPro, etc), a professional camera... As long as they provide the necessary sizes.

**AWARDS**

The most voted photo in the Public Award category will win a weekend (2 nights) with breakfast included at the Denia Marriott La Sella Hotel and a commemorative trophy.

### HOW TO PARTICIPATE IN THE GENERAL COMPETITION?

The Public Award is just one section of the international water sports photography competition "**Ocean Power Watersports Photography Awards**".

### PHOTOGRAPHS “PUBLIC AWARD”

Photos posted on Instagram Stories and sent by Direct Message must be the size recommended by the platform. The photos must be sent in **JPG** format.

In the case of winning the Public Award, the photo will be required to be at least 3,000 pixels in size (longest edge) and 300 dpi for printing.

- The photographs must be originals by the author.
- Participants are fully responsible for being the sole authors, for the absence of third party rights, as well as for any claim for image rights on the works submitted.
- Photomontages are not accepted.
- If there is any suspicion that a winning photograph may be a fraud, the jury may request the RAW file for verification.
- Photographs do not necessarily have to have been taken in the same year.

### DEADLINE FOR ADMISSION AND VOTING

The deadline for entries to the "Public Award" (Instagram) will be from **9 November at 17:00h to 23 November 2022 at 23:59h**.

The voting period for the photographs will run from **25 to 30 November 2022**.

The winner of the Public Award will be announced on **1 December** via Instagram @watersportspographyawards. The award will be presented in person at the awards gala on **7 January 2023**.

## **METHOD OF VOTING**

The photos received via Instagram @waterportsphotographyawards during the deadline for entries will be uploaded to a gallery that will be made public from **25 to 30 November**, where any individual can add a vote to the photo(s) of their choice.

## **REQUIREMENTS OF THE WINNERS**

The author of the photograph with the most votes from the public will be announced via Stories on the event's Instagram profile (@watersportsphotographyawards) on **1 December**.

Once the winner has re-uploaded the Story, they will be summoned to the awards ceremony. The winning photograph will be requested in large format for printing, along with a photo identifying the artist.

In the event of not being able to attend the ceremony, the winning photographer must connect live via videoconference or send a video with certain characteristics at least 15 days before the ceremony.

Failure to comply with these requirements will result in disqualification.
